On December 12, 2016, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an application from Black Hills Power, Inc. dba Black Hills Energy (BHP) for approval to extend the filing date of its vegetation management annual report to April 30, 2017. Per the Settlement Stipulation in EL12-061, BHP is required to provide an annual report by December 31 of each year to outline the progress made on the overall five-year plan and update the forecast for the remaining years based on actual progress to date. BHP states that due to an estimated first quarter 2017 trim cycle completion, BHP believes that it would be in the benefit of both the BHP and the Commission to delay its December filing requirement until April 30, 2017.

On December 15, 2016, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of December 19, 2016, to interested individuals and entities on the Commission's PUC Weekly Filings electronic listserv. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapter 1-26 and 49-34A.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on December 20, 2016, the Commission considered this matter. Commission staff stated they had no objection to BHP's request. The Commission voted unanimously to approve BHP's request for an extension until April 30, 2017, to file its 2016 annual report. It is therefore

ORDERED, that BHP's request for an extension until April 30, 2017, to file its vegetation management annual report is approved.
