ORDER GRANTING
INTERVENTION

On April 22, 2013, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received an Application from Boomerang Wireless, LLC d/b/a enTouch Wireless (enTouch Wireless) for Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier for the Limited Purpose of Offering Wireless Lifeline Service to Qualified Households.

On April 25, 2013, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of May 10, 2013, to interested individuals and entities. On May 9, 2013, South Dakota Telecommunications Association (SDTA) filed a Petition to Intervene. On May 31, 2013, enTouch Wireless filed a letter stating that it had no objection to SDTA's intervention in this docket.

The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to SDCL Chapters 1-26 and 49-31 and ARSD 20:10:01:15.05.

At its regularly scheduled meeting of June 4, 2013, the Commission heard the argument of SDTA. The Commission found that the Petition to Intervene of SDTA demonstrated good cause to grant intervention and voted unanimously to grant intervention to SDTA. It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Petition to Intervene of SDTA is hereby granted.
