On May 23, 2013, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Knology of the Plains, Inc. (Knology) for approval of tariff changes with an effective date of July 2, 2013. The tariff revisions reflect changes to certain rates and are intended to bring Knology's intrastate rates to parity with its interstate Rates as of July 2, 2013.

On May 30, 2013, the Commission electronically transmitted notice of the filing and the intervention deadline of June 14, 2013, to interested individuals and entities. No petitions to intervene or comments were filed.
