## Inspection Priorities

- Annual inspection of O&M records, emergency training records, and other records to confirm compliance with minimum gas safety standards on all intrastate operators and on any systems contracted by these operators
- Review of previous annual PHMSA reports

## Inspection Priorities (cont.)

- For special inspections, operator will be selected for inspection once within each calendar year or sooner, based on the following criteria:
  - ☐ History of violations and warnings
  - □ Facilities requiring special maintenance considerations such as cast iron, bare steel
  - □ Special activities such as new construction, uprates, etc.

# Inspection Priorities (cont.)

- ☐ Seasonal activities
- ☐ Initial or follow-up inspections with deadlines
- □ Operators with high risk areas
- ☐ Specific activities including construction activities, personnel changes, operating procedure changes, uprates, class location changes, etc.

#### Other Considerations

- The following items are not currently in our written plan but are under consideration:
  - □ For large operators, rotation of locations inspected such as a percentage of areas inspected per CY
  - ☐ Target cycle is to perform annual Standard Inspections for Records Review
  - □ Complaints received

#### Other Considerations (cont.)

- OQ on a yearly basis for operators and their contractors
- PA, IMP, DIMP, Drug & Alcohol once per 2-4 years.
- Construction
  - New transmission additions
    - Distribution –will inspect operators and their contractors each calendar year or more often as operator construction schedule time allows
- □ PSOT once very 3 years minimum
- Operator assistance visits as needed
