On October 3, 2012 the South Dakota One Call Board issued an Order to Stromseth Construction in regards to Complaint Docket OC12-012. The Order called for a total payment amount of \$15,000, \$2,500 of which was suspended with conditions. Those conditions were:

- (i) Stromseth shall make payment of the \$2,500 unsuspended penalty within 30 days of issuance of the Order.
- (ii) Stromseth Construction must not be found guilty of a One Call violation in the next 12 months.
- (iii) Stromseth Construction must attend a spring 2013 South Dakota One Call excavator meeting.
- (iv) Stromseth Construction shall conduct an in-house gas safety meeting for its employees. The meeting shall be held within 30 days of the Order. Documentation shall include the printed and signed names of the meeting participants, details of the material discussed along with the date and length of the meeting. Documentation shall be submitted to the Executive Director of South Dakota One Call.

If any of the conditions were not met the suspended payment amount would be due. A payment of \$2,500 was received at the Public Utilities Commission on October 9, 2012, however, condition (iv) was not met, which means the remaining balance of \$12,500 is now due. That amount includes the \$2,500 suspended amount, along with the remaining penalty amount of \$10,000 indicated in the Order.
