Comments: This pipeline passes nearby our property on land originally homesteaded by my grandfather. The 2012 Brass Family LLLP owns the home acreage (8 acres) which is nearby the pipeline route (likely within 300') and is already encumbered by the Lewis and Clark water pipeline which passes directly over the acreage. I am very concerned that:

1. This prime acreage's value (in the growth pattern of Sioux Falls) would decrease significantly
2. The possibility of a leak would be of great concern to the environment and again, devalue the property significantly and
3. The value of the farmland itself, which we don't own but have been in discussions with the owners to do so, would also be greatly impaired.
