ORDER

GW17-002

The South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) revoked H & I Grain of Hetland, Inc.'s (H & I Grain) grain buyer's license on July 24, 2017, in Docket No. GW17-001. In that Order, the Commission ordered a new docket be opened to address the disbursement of the bond proceeds pursuant to SDCL 49-45-19.

On April 12, 2018, the Commission issued an Order for Distribution of Bond Proceeds. On April 13, 2018, the Commission received a Petition to Appoint South Dakota Public Utilities Commission as Receiver from several sellers represented by Mr. Gary Schumacher. The matter was taken up and thoroughly discussed at the April 20, May 1, and July 26, 2018, Commission meetings and deferred each time for additional information.

The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-45-16.1.

At its regular meeting on August 7, 2018, the Commission considered the petition to take receivership. The Commission voted unanimously to request permission from the circuit court to take receivership of H&I Grain for the sole purpose of selling the corporation to a consortium of individuals and entities who have not been fully paid for grain sold to H&I Grain.

It is therefore

ORDERED, that the Commission shall request permission from the circuit court to take receivership of H&I Grain for the sole purpose of selling the corporation to a consortium of individuals and entities who have not been fully paid for grain sold to H&I Grain.
