*It is crucial to the health, safety, and welfare of the people of South Dakota, and of America, that you reject the Keystone XL Pipeline certification in docket HP14-001. The final Environmental Impact Statement submitted by the State Department shows that this pipeline is **expected** to leak ten times, at least, over the course of its lifetime. This means that risks to South Dakota's water - the Oglala Aquifer and the Missouri River and rural water systems, affecting many other states, and to people's livelihoods, is unacceptable. Our best climate scientists have also warned over and over again that the operation of the Keystone XL will push our climate crisis past a point of no return, with impacts nationally and globally. We cannot risk the safety and security of our water supply, our land, and our citizens for the most toxic and dangerous form of oil.*
