This is in response to your Sept. 28, 2023, email regarding the motion filed for release of the Dakota Access, LLC construction bond and public liaison officer.

The formal parties in the HP14-002 docket, including you as an intervenor, will receive a copy of the Public Utilities Commission meeting agenda relaying when the motion is to be heard, as is the proper process of notification by the commission. In addition, the commission served a formal notice upon the docket's service list, signed Sept. 26, 2023. Because you were represented by an attorney in this matter, your attorney would have received that notice.

The commission follows South Dakota's open meeting laws in notifying formal parties and in conducting its meetings.
