**MOTION TO RELEASE  
CONSTRUCTION BOND AND  
TERMINATE THE APPOINTMENT OF  
PUBLIC LIAISON OFFICER**

COMES NOW the Applicant and Permittee, by and through its attorneys of record, Brett Koenecke and Cody Honeywell, of May, Adam, Gerdes & Thompson LLP, and moves the Commission for an Order releasing the construction bond on file with the Commission pursuant to law and terminating the appointment of Eric Munz as Project Liaison.

The Applicant and Permittee makes these motions based on the fact that construction is long concluded, and no further road issues related to the pipeline's construction are thought to exist or to arise in the future. Further, the reclamation and restoration of land over the pipeline, pursuant to construction, has been long concluded, and no need for a Public Liaison Officer exists at present or into the future. No report has been filed for some time; the last report indicates no issues remaining. The Applicant remains committed to the project stakeholders and to its permit conditions. The Applicant will follow through on those commitments through its own established processes.

WHEREUPON, Applicant and Permittee requests the Commission enter its Order releasing the construction bond and terminating the appointment of Eric Munz as Public Liaison and the need for his activities and reporting going forward.
