

**Dakota Access Pipeline**  
**South Dakota Reclamation Update**  
**10-08-2018**

As of October 8, 2018 there are 14 known reclamation issues remaining due to the construction, installation, operation, and maintenance of the Dakota Access Pipeline (DAPL). Due to continuous rain events and saturated soil, these items have not been resolved. Local contractors have been retained to complete the work when conditions allow.

- 8 issues including low/ponding areas, sinkholes, debris, or tile issues are scheduled to be completed by October 15, 2018, weather permitting.
- 2 tile issues are to be verified and a plan for reclamation developed if necessary when conditions permit.
- 1 ditch line sinkage issue is to be remedied after standing crops are removed.
- 1 drainage issue plan is currently being formulated.
- 2 regrowth and weed issues are planned for weed mitigation and re-seeding in spring of 2019.
