The enclosed Summons and Complaint are served upon you as attorney for the above-named defendants pursuant to SDCL §15-6-4(i).

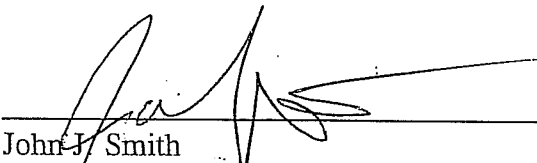
You must complete the admission part of this form and return one copy of the completed form to the sender within twenty (20) days.

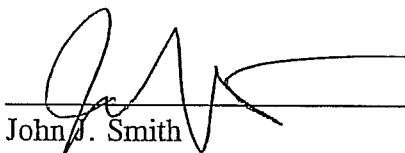
