JOINT REQUEST FOR ELECTRIC SERVICE TERRITORY EXCEPTION


The City of Sioux Falls Electric Utility and Northern States Power Company jointly request an exception to the existing electric service territorial agreement to permit Northern States Power Company to provide electric service to all of the property known as "Hidden Meadows Manufactured Home Park". Phase I. II. and III. and land that could possibly be future development that lies adjacent to and East of the "Hidden Meadows" property. Property description is the portion of Tract 1 lying East of Lot E in Tract 1, except the North 240' of the East 300'; and all of the Burlington Northern Addition, except the North 240', and Tract 1 in the Sioux Falls Rendering Addition, except the North 240', all in the SW 1/4 of Section 10, Township 101 North, Range 49 West of the 6th P.M., Minnehaha County, SD and Lot E of said Tract 1. A drawing of the described area is attached. In exchange for the above, the City of Sioux Falls Electric Utility will take over and maintain three hundred thirty-three (333) 100 watt high pressure sodium street lights, twelve (12) 150 watt high pressure sodium street lights. and thirty-three (33) 250 watt high pressure sodium street lights at various locations within the City corporate limits. These street lights are currently owned by and maintained by Northern States Power Company. The City of Sioux Falls Electric Utility owns and maintains all other street lighting currently within the corporate limits of Sioux Falls.

Representatives of both the City of Sioux Falls Electric Utility and Northern States Power Company have met on several occasions and have make a thorough study of this territory trade. It is our mutual agreement that this trade would be in the best interest of the customers served by both utilities.


Both utilities also agree that such instances where territory boundaries become a factor, they should be dealt with on an individual basis, with decisions based on what is in the best interest of the customer

This exception is not to be construed as having any impact upon or indicating a desire to change the service areas assigned by the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission.



On May 6, 1996, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Northern States Power Company of 500 West Russell, Sioux Falls, SD (NSP) seeking approval of an agreement for service rights exception. The purpose of the filing was to seek Commission approval for an exchange of service areas. In its application NSP states that "[c]urrent service areas of the applicants were assigned by the Commission in its Order (F-3107) dated September 7, 1976, which Order incorporated by reference a contract between the applicants in regard to assigned service areas dated August 29, 1976. "Generally, the current agreement between the City of Sioux Falls Electric Utility and NSP proposes that NSP be allowed to provide electric service to all property known is "Hidden Meadows Manufactured Home Park" Phases I, II, and III as well as future development property lying east of the "Hidden Meadows" property. In exchange, the City of Sioux Falls Electric Utility would take over and maintain 378 street lights within the corporate limits of Sioux Falls. South Dakota

NSP and the City of Sioux Falls Electric Utility have entered into an agreement entitled "Joint Request For Electric Service Territory Exception," dated May 28, 1996, and have filed same along with maps delineating the affected territories.

The area to be served by NSP is described as:

That portion of Tract 1 lying East of Lot E in Tract 1, except the North 240 feet of the East 300 feet, and all of the Burlington Northern Addition, except the North 240 feet, and Tract 1 in the Sioux Falls Rendering Addition, except the North 240 feet, and Lot E of said Tract 1, all in the Southwest quarter (SW1/4) of Section 10, Township 101 North, Range 49. West of the 6th P M. Minnehaha Country, South Dakota

The street lights to be served by the City of Sioux Falls Utility are:

- 1 Three hundred thirty-three (333) one hundred watt high pressure sodium street lights, and
 - 2. Twelve (12) one hundred fifty watt high pressure sodium street lights; and
 - 3 Thirty three (33) two hundred fifty watt high pressure sodium street lights.

All of these are located at various locations within the corporate limits of the City of SiQux Falls and are located at positions indicated on diagrams on file with the Commission.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-34A, specifically, 49-34A-4, 49-34A-42, and 49-34A-55. Further, the Commission finds that the service rights transfer is in the public interest and the request shall be granted. As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore

ORDERED that the request seeking approval of service territory transfer is hereby granted
