COMES NOW, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co., a Division of MDU
Resources Group, Inc., the Applicant in the above-entitled
proceeding (hereafter "Montana-Dakota" or "Applicant"), and
respectfully states as follows:

Ι.

That Montana-Dakota, a Division of MDU Resources Group, Inc., is a Delaware corporation duly authorized to do business in the State of South Dakota as a foreign corporation, and that it is doing business in the State of South Dakota as a public utility.

That Montana-Dakota's Certificate of Incorporation and Amendments thereto have previously been filed with the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (PUC or Commission) and reference thereto is hereby made, and such Certificate and Amendments are hereby incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth herein.

That Applicant's full name and post office address are:

IV.

That each electric utility in South Dakota has the exclusive right to provide electric service at retail in assigned service areas pursuant to SDCL \$49-34A-42, which also provides that no electric utility shall render or extend electric service at retail within the assigned service area of another electric utility unless such other electric utility consents thereto in writing and the agreement is approved by the Commission consistent with SDCL \$49-34A-55.

v.

That the City of Herreid, South Dakota (City) recently annexed property into the city limits in which the City desires two new street lights to be located.

VI.

That the location of one of the new street lights is in the assigned electric service area of Cam Wal Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Cam Wal).

That Montana-Dakota presently serves all street lighting needs of the City pursuant to a Street Lighting Agreement.

VIII.

That Montana-Dakota's present facilities are closer to the location where the City desires the two street lights to be located in the newly annexed addition and the City desires that Montana-Dakota install and serve the two street lights to avoid duplication of service providers for the City's street lighting system.

IX.

That to avoid duplication and cost of facilities, Cam Wal is willing to allow Montana-Dakota the limited right to serve the one new street light in Cam Wal's otherwise assigned service area in the new City addition.

х.

That SDCL \$49-34A-55 provides that electric utilities can change electric distribution service rights by written mutual agreement and subject to Commission approval.

XI.

That SDCL \$49-34A-55 further provides that any agreement which changes assigned service areas shall be filed with and approved by the Commission before it may become effective.

That on May 17, 1996, Montana-Dakota and Cam Wal entered into a Service Area Modification Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", wherein Cam Wal grants Montana-Dakota the limited right to construct, operate, and provide electric service at retail to the one electric street light to be located within Cam Wal's assigned electric service area in Section 6, Township 127N, Range 76W, Campbell County, South Dakota, as shown on Exhibit "B", attached hereto.

XIII.

That Cam Wal grants Montana-Dakota permission, subject to Commission approval hereunder, to extend Montana-Dakota's electric line to serve the above street light in Cam Wal's otherwise assigned service area. The street light shall consist of a 150 watt sodium vapor light to be constructed on a 40 foot street light pole. The light will be served from #4 duplex underground conductor so that no other loads can be served by Montana-Dakota off this circuit.

XIV.

That except as stated in Exhibit "A", Cam Wal reserves its rights under South Lakota law to serve the retail customers and accounts that locate within its assigned electric service area.

That the Service Area Modification Agreement between Montana-Dakota and Cam Wal dated May 17, 1996, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein, is hereby submitted to the Commission for approval pursuant to SDCL §49-34A-55.

XVT

That Cam Wal and Montana-Dakota agree to Montana-Dakota's submittal of attached Exhibits "A" and "B" for Commission approval pursuant to SDCL §49-34A-55 without a request for a formal hearing by the Commission.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that the Public Utilities Commission of South Dakota:

- Approve Exhibits "A" and "B" attached hereto and incorporated herein agreeing to a change in service area;
- 2. Grant approval without the need for a formal hearing; and
- Grant such other and additional relief as the Commission shall deem just and proper.

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this /7 day of May, 1996, by and between CAM WAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC. (Ca# Wal) and MONTANA-DAKOTA UTILITIES CO., a Division of MDU Resources Group, Inc. (Montana-Dakota).

WHEREAS, the City of Herreid, South Dakota (City) recently annexed property into the city limits in which the City desires two new street lights to be located; and

WHEREAS, the location of one of the new street lights is in the assigned electric service area of Cam Wal; and

WHEREAS, Montana-Dakota presently serves all street lighting needs of the City of Herreid pursuant to a Street Lighting Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Montana-Dakota's present facilities are closer to the location where the City desires the two street lights to be located in the newly annexed addition and the City desires that Montana-Dakota install and serve the two street lights to avoid duplication of service providers for the City's street lighting system; and

WHEREAS, to avoid duplication and cost of facilities, Cam Wal is willing to allow Montana-Pakota the limited right to serve the one new street light in Cam Wal's otherwise assigned service area; and

WHEREAS, SDCL § 49-34A-42 provides that no electric utility shall render or extend electric service at retail within the assigned service area of another electric utility unless such other electric utility consents thereto in writing and the agreement is approved by the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission consistent with SDCL §49-34A-55;

NOW, THEREFORE, Cam Wal and Montana-Dakota agree as follows:

- Subject to South Dakota Public Utilities Commission approval pursuant to SDCL \$49-14A-55\$, Cam Wal grants Montana-Dakota the limited right to construct, operate and provide electric service at retail to one electric street light located within Cam Wal's assigned electric service area in Section 6, Township 127N, Range 76W, Campbell County, South Dakota, as shown on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- 2. Cam Wal grants Montana-Dakota permission to extend its electric line to serve the street light in Cam Wal's assigned service area. The street light shall consist of a 150 watt sodium vapor light to be constructed on a 40 foot street light pole. The light will be served from #4 duplex underground conductor so that no other loads can be served by Montana-Dakota off this circuit.



On June 17, 1996, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a filing from Montana-Dakota Utilities. Inc. (MDU) for approval of a service area exception. The purpose of the filing was to seek Commission approval for MDU to accommodate the City of Herreid, South Dakota (the City), who has requested two new street lights in a recently annexed area. One of the street lights is located within Cam Wal Electric Cooperative's (Cam Wal) territory, MDU has a Street Lighting Agreement with the City to serve all street lights in Herreid. MDU submitted a letter of justification, a map and plat of the affected area, and a copy of a "Service Area Modification Agreement," which MDU and Cam Wal had signed, signifying their agreement. The City signified their agreement by separate writing.

The property which is the subject of this request for approval is described as "one electric street light located within Cam Wals' assigned electric service area in Section 6, Township 127N, Range 76W. Campbell County, South Dakota." The street light will be a "150 wait sodium vapor light to be constructed on a 40 foot street light pole." The agreement further provided MDU could extend its electric line to serve the street light with a #4 duplex underground conductor so that no other loads can be served by MDU of this circuit.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-34A, specifically, 49-34A-42, and 49-34A-55. Further, the Commission finds that granting the service rights transfer will avoid the unnecessary duplication of facilities, provide adequate service to the City, and promote the efficient use and development of the electric systems of the contracting electric utilities. The Commission therefore concludes that the request is in the public interest and shall be granted.

As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore

ORDERED that the request seeking approval of service area modification agreement is hereby granted.
