On October 30, 2000, the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) received a joint request from Sioux Valley-Southwestern Electric Cooperative, Inc. (SVSW) and The City of Brockings. South Dakota (Brookings) seeking approval of an agreement for a service rights exception. The purpose of the filling was to seek Commission approval for an exception to the existing electric service territorial agreement. According to the application, "The City of Brookings and Sigux Valley-Southwestern Electric Cooperative jointly request an exception to the existing electric service territorial agreement to permit The City of Brookings to provide electric service to the Kathy Mennier residence in the Southwest Quarter of Section 18, Township 110 North, Range 49 West."

SVSW and Brookings have entered into an agreement entitled "Joint Request for Electric Service Territory Exception" dated October 16, 2000, and have filed the same with a signature of consent signed by the affected customer concurring with the territorial transfer.

On November 30, 2000, at its regularly scheduled meeting, the Commission sensitiered the matter. Commission Staff recommended approval of the joint request.

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to SDCL 49-34A, specifically, 49-34A-4, 49-34A-42, and 49-34A-55. Further, the Commission finds that the service rights transfer is in the public interest and the request shall be granted. As the Commission's final decision in this matter, it is therefore
