This letter is in regard to the status of the electric service provider for the area along East Main and specifically to your residence. Clay Union Electric, at it's regularly scheduled board meeting last month discussed the current and long term service arrangements for this specific area.

As you may recall certain electric service areas within the City of Vermillion are governed an electric service contract between the City of Vermillion and Clay Union Electric. This contract defines an orderly process for transfer of service from Clay Union Electric to the City of Vermillion. Over the past years this process has provided for the transfer of services whereby at the present time, only your residence remains to be served by our electric facilities.

At its' last meeting, the Board discussed this current service arrangement and concluded that it may be prudent at this time to consider completing the electric service transfers to the City of Vermillion. Because you are a member of Clay Union Electric, our first step in initiating a transfer action is to determine whether the action would be satisfactory to you.

Clay Union Electric's ability to continue to serve your location with a sufficient supply of quality electric power is not at risk, nor the impetus for the transfer discussion at this time.

Any costs associated with Clay Union Electric's role in this transfer would not be billed to you. Should you approve of the transfer, and agreement with the City of Vermillion is achieved, the transfer would be at your convenience and be accomplished with only minor electric service interruption.





If you would like us to initiate discussion with the City of Vermillion regarding a transfer arrangement, your signing a copy of this letter and returning it to us would begin this process.

Our letter to them inquiring of their interest in a transfer is attached. As you can see from the letter, they agree to the switch.

Please feel free to give me some feedback on the process. It would seem that we ought to agree on a time schedule for accomplishing this transfer. The City of Vermillion has a little more work to do to initiate service than we do to essentially disconnect service. therefor the schedule may be more significant for your work. If we did the transfer on the first of the month it might make the billing arrangements easier but certainly that is not mandatory.

I would also think that we might need to send notice to the PUC as they technically have oversight over territorial activities. Not sure if they would approve knowing the member consents to the change. My guess is that they would require this to go through a normal commission meeting in order to officially act on it however. That might require a little time to get on their agenda.

If you would like me to, I would be willing to call the PUC and then follow up with a letter to get this process started. I would also check to see if a formal hearing is necessary.
