West side of Sec. 6) - Moved to west side of road because landowners Ralph, Nancy, and Marjorie Schmidt were more favorable to the project.

Made change because of conflicts with Cold Springs Granite mining permit on the north end and landowners Gary and Cathy Schuelke to the south wanted the line moved to the east side of the road. The line was moved to the south and east to accommodate these requests and to provide the best engineering solution.

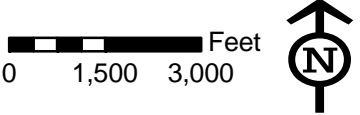
