Enclosed for filing please find a revised copy of an executed "Joint Request for Electric Service Territory Exception" between Southeastern Electric Cooperative and Sioux Valley-Southwestern Electric Cooperative (SVE).

Southeastern Electric Cooperative and SVE jointly request an exception to the existing electric service territorial agreement to permit SVE to provide electric service to the City of Sioux Falls Regional Sanitary Landfill in the Northwest quarter of Section 7, Township 100 North, Range 51 West.

Pursuant to South Dakota Statute 49-34A-55 this Territory Exception will eliminate the duplication of facilities. SVE already has existing three phase service to another Sioux Falls Regional Sanitary Landfill service approximately 1220 feet from the new requested three phase service. This exception would also allow SVE to continue providing adequate electric service to this consumer which ultimately will provide efficient and economical use and development of our electric system.

The consumer is in favor of this transfer and has signed the attached agreement showing their concurrence.

Sioux Valley Southwestern Electric respectfully requests the consideration of the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission and an order approving this agreement.

JOINT REQUEST FOR ELECTRIC SERVICE TERRITORY EXCEPTION
(A05.6)

Southeastern Electric Cooperative, Inc. and Sioux Valley Southwestern Electric Cooperative, Inc., doing business as Sioux Valley Energy (SVE) jointly request an exception to the existing electric service territorial agreement to permit SVE to provide electric service to a new pond site for Sioux Falls Landfill. The service will be located in the NW ¼ of Section 7, Township 100 North, Range 51 West. A drawing of the service site, Exhibit A05.6, is attached for your information.

Representatives of both SVE and Southeastern Electric have concluded that, in this instance, the customer's interest will be best served by receiving service from SVE and have agreed that we should request an exception to the existing territorial agreement.

We have also agreed that each such instance where territory boundaries become a factor should be dealt with on an individual basis.


This consent on the part of SVE is limited to the above said service and will automatically terminate upon removal or abandonment of such services.

This exception is not to be construed as having any impact upon or indicating a desire to change the service area assigned by the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission.


