Thank you. I will consider your responses to be a stipulation among all parties to a two week extension of the dates for the filing of testimony and other procedural dates. By my reckoning, this will move the date for Staff and Intervenors Testimony back to November 10 and for BHP's Rebuttal back to November 22. As you probably know, scheduling alternative hearing dates can be problematic since we then have the Commissioners' schedules to deal with. For that reason, at this time, I suggest we do a Second Scheduling Order and Order Cancelling Hearing, and as we get a little further along, we'll do another Notice of Hearing if that proves necessary. I will cc this message to Heather Forney, our scheduling officer, to let her know of the change and of the need to search for alternative hearing dates. When she has located available dates, I'll circulate them to you to make sure of your availability. Once we've cleared alternative hearing dates, we'll reserve them, but put off doing the Notice of Hearing until we believe the settlement process in at an impasse. How does this sound to everybody?
