Pursuant to SDCL 49-47B-15 and 49-47B-17, the Commission (Commission) will hold a public hearing on an application filed by Navitas Energy, a wholly owned subsidiary of Navitas Energy, for conversion facility, permit to construct and The White Wind Farms, a proposed 200 MW wind farm and ancillary services located on Township southeast of White, South Dakota consists of up to 105.2 MW wind turbine generator lines, a collection substation and interconnection White Substation.

At the hearing, interested persons may air views and comments regarding the application. The applications on file in the Brookings County Commission's office in the Capitol Building and all other documents in the case may also be viewed on the Commission's website at www.puc.sd.gov under "Commission Dockets" 2006 Bi-County Dockets # 06-020.

The parties to this proceeding are either Pursuant to SDCL 49-47B-17, any person or organization, including but not limited to each municipality, county, and government agency, or a non-profit organization formed in whole or in part for the purpose of protecting the natural beauty, to protect the environmental values to preserve historical sites, to promote commercial and industrial groups, or to protect the project area or any interested person, may participate in this proceeding by making written application to the Commission on or before the date provided in ARSD 20-10-22-40, or on forms for party status will be available and available on August 24, 2006.

For approval, Navitas must show that the project will not cause any significant injury to the environment nor to the social, economic, or expected inhabitants in the siting area, health, safety or welfare of the inhabitants, or the orderly development of the region with respect to the views of governing bodies of the region. Based upon these factors, the Commission should be granted, denied or granted upon conditions of the construction, operation or maintenance of the project are appropriate.

The parties will have the right to appeal the Commission's decision to the appropriate Circuit Court by serving and filing a notice of appeal in accordance with SDCL 26-31 in writing within 30 days of the date of service of the notice of entry of decision. 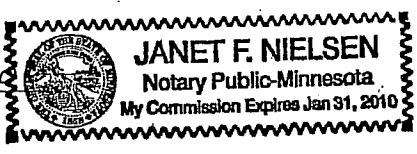
