NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING SOUTH DAKOTA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION

WHAT - East River Electric Power Gooperative, Inc. Transmission Line Projects Lincoln and Tomer Counties, South Dakota

WHEN: Thursday August 7, 2008, at 6:00 p.m. CDT WHERE American Legion Post 283, Main Street, Chancellor, South Dakota

Pursuant to SDCL 49 41B-15 and 49 41B-16, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) will hold a public input bearing at the above time and place on an application filed by East Piver Electric Power Cooperative line (East River) for a Facility Remnittoronstruct a 115 kV transmission line between the Virgil Fodness High Voltage Substation located south of Jea in Lincoln County and the Chancellor.
Substation located east of Chancellor in Turner County. The line is needed to serve the expansion of an ethanol plantserved by East Rivers member system. Southeastern Electric Cooperative, Inc.; as well as other loads which continue to growin Turner and Lincoln Counties.

Witherhearing, East River will present a brief description of the project following which interested persons may appear and present their questions, views and comments regarding the application; Pursuant to SDCL 49-41B-15(5), the application is on file in the Eurocin County Auditors effice and Timer County Auditors office and in the Commission's office in Pierre and the application and all other documents in the cases may also be accessed on the Commission's web site at www.puc.sd.gov.under Commission Actions, Commission Dockets, Electric. Dockets, 2008 Electric Dockets, EL08-016.

Interparties to this proceeding are currently East Biver and the Commission: Pursuant to SDCL 49-418-17, any person residing in the already tiespreject, each municipality, county, and governmentallegency. In the project area, any non-profit organization formed in whole or in particle. itomatic conservation or natural beauty, to protect the environment, personal health or other piotogical values to preserve historical sites to torrigie consumer interests, to represent commercial and industrial groups, or to promote the orderly development of the project area to read officested person, may be granted formal party status in this proceeding by making written application to the Commission as provided in the second status will be available at the public input hearing on August 7. 2008: or may be obtained from the Commission.

Following the public input hearing, the Commission may schedule one or more subsequent formal evidentiary hearings conforming to SDEL Chapter, i-26 to consider any issues raised by any intervening party. Commission Staff or the Commission itself. At such formal hearing, all parties will have the opportunity to appear, present evidence and cross-examine the other parties, winesses and exercise all other nights. afforded by SDCL 1=26,49-1 and 49-41B and ARSD 2010:01 and 20:10:22. Absent a confested issue, the Commission will schedule the matter for decision at a regular or special meeting of the Commission.

For approval, East River must show that the proposed transmission line project will comply with all applicable laws and rules will not pose a 🗦 threat of serious injury to the environment nor to the socializand economic condition of inhabitants or expected inhabitants in the sitting area, will not substantially impair the health, safety or welfare of the inhabitants, and will not unduly interfere with the orderly development of the region with due consideration having been given to the views of governing bodies of affected local units of government. Based upon these factors, the Commission will decide whether the permit should be granted, denied or granted upon such terms, conditions of modifications of the construction, operation or maintenance as the Commission finds are appropriate. The parties will have the right to appealable final decision in this case to the appropriate Circuit Court by serving and filing a notice of appeal of the decision in accordance with SDCL 1-26-34,.. within thirty (30) days after the date of service of the notice of decision in this case.
