Northern States Power Company, a Minnesota corporation (the "Company" or "Xcel Energy") operating in South Dakota, submitted its application to the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (the "Commission") for authority to increase rates for electric service in South Dakota on June 30, 2009. The Commission issued its ORDER FOR AND NOTICE OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND HEARING ("Order") in this matter on September 30, 2009.

We propose to suspend the procedural schedule set forth in the Commission's Order by one week so that settlement discussions can continue without simultaneously having to contend with testimony deadlines. Due to the Thanksgiving holiday, we recognize that the suspension would result in the due date for Staff testimony to be delayed until November 30.
