Basin Electric Power Cooperative appreciates your assistance on August 7th as Banner Engineering conducted their final evaluation of the condition of roads in Alton Township which were traversed by construction workers and delivery drivers during the construction of the Deer Creek Station.

In a letter dated August 9, 2012, Banner Engineering relayed to us the costs for gravel and repairs to bring the roads up to pre-construction condition. Banner states that Richland Township is due a total of \$10,538.22, and you will find a check enclosed for that amount.

Please confirm your agreement that the reimbursement of these funds fulfills Richland Township's expectations that the roads in the Township have been returned to a condition comparable to their condition prior to construction by returning a signed copy of this letter to my attention at Basin Electric.
