OUTDOOR LIGHTING AND MUNICIPAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made by and between Otter Tail Power Company (the "Company"), a Minnesota corporation, and City of Gary, SD (the "Customer").

In consideration of the mutual promises contained below, the parties agree as follows:

1. The Customer agrees to purchase and receive from the Company the electric services identified in this Agreement, in accordance with the terms of this Agreement and all terms and conditions and rules and regulations (the "Terms") established by the Company and filed in its tariff with the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission, as the same may be amended from time to time.
2. The Company shall provide and the Customer shall pay for the services specified in this Agreement for a term of one (1) years (but in no event less than a minimum term of (1) one year) with an effective date of the term to begin December 9, 2010, and terminating December 9, 2011, and thereafter shall be renewed for periods of one year each, unless written notice to the contrary is given by either party to the other not less than thirty (30) days before the expiration of this agreement or any renewal thereof. The Customer Charge and fixed charges from the applicable rate schedule shall apply as long as the Customer is taking service from the Company.

If Customer does not receive any one or more of the services described below, indicate by inserting "N/A" as appropriate.

The Company will not be liable for incidental or consequential damages, including, but not limited to, loss of profits resulting from the use of service or any delay, interruption, curtailment, suspension, disturbance or variability of electric service. The Company shall have the right to suspend temporarily the delivery of electric power hereunder for the purpose of making repairs or improvements of its system.
- 14. If applicable, the Company shall charge for and the Customer shall pay any additional costs associated with Special Facilities as identified in Section 5.02 of the General Rules and Regulations. The total cost of Special Facilities identified is \$ _____.
- 15. All previous agreements, if any, between the parties covering the subject matter hereof are hereby cancelled and terminated as of the effective date specified in Paragraph 2 of this Agreement, except as specifically provided in this Agreement.
