- -BEGINNING at the point on the northern border of Corson County, South Dakota where the eastern border of the SW ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 23 of Township 23 North (T23N), Range 17 East (R17E) intersects with the North Dakota border.
- -THENCE continue south to the SW corner of the NE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 26, T23N, R17E,
- -THENCE continue east to the SE corner of the NE ¼ of the NW ¼ of Section 25, T23N, R17E.
- -THENCE continue north to the point where the eastern border of the NW ¼ of Section 24, T23N, R17E intersects with the North Dakota border.

1) Two (2) customers located in the W ½ of Section 24, T23N, R17E:

Keldron: (Exhibit B – page 2)

- -BEGINNING at the SW corner of the NE ¼ of the SW ¼ of Section 30, T23N, R19E,
- -THENCE continue north approximately one (1) mile to a point approximately 1,320 feet north of the southern border of Section 19 of T23N, R19E, and approximately 1,320 feet east of the western border of Section 19, T23N, R19E,
- -THENCE continue east approximately one (1) mile to a point approximately 1,320 feet east of the western border of Section 20, T23N, R19E, and approximately 1,320 feet north of the southern border of Section 20, T23N, R19E,
- -THENCE continue south to the SE corner of the NW ¼ of the SW ¼ of Section 29, T23N, R19E,

- -THENCE continue south to the SE corner of the SW ¼ of the SW ¼ of Section 28, T23N, R21E,
- -THENCE continue west to the SE corner of Section 29, T23N, R21E,
- -THENCE continue south approximately 150 feet to the centerline of the railroad right-of-way (ROW),
- -THENCE continue northwesterly along the centerline of the railroad ROW to the southern border of Section 29, T23N, R21E,
- -THENCE continue west to the SW corner of Section 29, T23N, R21E,
- -THENCE continue north to the point of origin.
