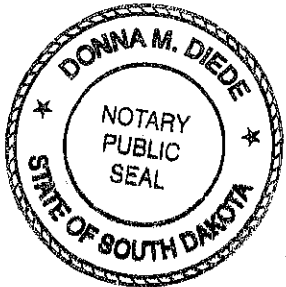

NOTICE BY THE SOUTH DAKOTA OF THE PROPOSED SALE OF LC

On July 15, 2014, the South Dakota Commission received a joint application to change telephone exchanges from Kite Parent Company Finance, LLC, ("WOW!"), on behalf of the Plains, Inc.; Knology of the Black Hills, Inc.; Knology of South Dakota, Inc. (collectively referred to as "WOW! LLC" ("Clarity"). WOW! South Dakota proposes changes to Clarity. The proposed sale includes changes and includes the following counties: Beresford, Black Hawk, Box Elder, Casper, Custer, DeSmet, Elk River, Fort Pierre, Hurley, Irene, Lead, Lennox, Parker, Piedmont, Rapid City, Sioux Falls, Vermillion, Viborg, Volin, and Worthing, and Yankton. The application is for the following reasons: 1) while operational functions were completed in Minnesota, and Iowa; 2) Clarity plans to provide enhanced 911; 3) there will be no change in rates for telephone exchanges resulting from the proposed sale; 4) there will be no change in state of South Dakota resulting solely from the proposed sale; 5) there will be no change in telephone exchanges; 6) Clarity is committed to providing telecommunications services; and 7) there will be no reduction, or impairment of any of the services.

The public is invited to participate in the Commission within 15 days of publication. The public may petition for intervention as a party to the proceeding. The procedure set forth in ARSD 17:01 is applicable. A copy of the application may be obtained by contacting the Commission. Comments must be received by the Commission within 15 days of publication. If sufficient public interest is demonstrated, the Commission may schedule a public hearing. The Commission shall issue a final decision on the application. SDCL 49-31-59.
