**REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL

Pursuant to ARSD 20:10:01:41, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. and Otter Tail Power Company, through their undersigned counsel, request confidential treatment as follows:

1. Confidential protection is sought for the following:
 - a. BSSE 64 to 267, which is produced in response to the Staff's data request 2-7, and which contains a chart depicting by land parcel requests for route changes, analysis of the Project of such requests, and the decision on the requests.
 - b. BSSE 329 to 331, which is produced in response to Staff's data request 2-11, which contains confidential appraisal information.


The pages of BSSE 64 to 267, and 329 to 331 are all marked confidential and are being provided on a CD, which is contained in sealed envelopes.

BSSE 64 to 267 contain appraisal and land value information that constitute trade secrets, or other confidential research, development, or commercial information protected by SDCL 15-6-26(c)(7).
