Legal Description of the Electric Service Territory Boundary between Central Electric Cooperative, Inc. and Charles Mix Electric Cooperative, Inc.

Based on a prior agreement dated the 5th day of December, 1975, signed by Tri-County Electric Association, Inc. and Charles Mix Electric Association, Inc., the following represents the legal description of the electric service territory boundary shared between Central Electric Cooperative, Inc. and Charles Mix Electric Cooperative, Inc.

1. BEGINNING at the Aurora County/Charles Mix County/Douglas County boundary at the NE corner of Section 12 of Township 100 North (T100N), Range 67 West, Charles Mix County,
2. THENCE continue west following the Charles Mix County/Aurora County-Brule County boundary ending at the intersection of Charles Mix County, Brule County, Lyman County, and Gregory County at the NW corner of Section 7 of T100N, Range 71 West, Charles Mix County.
