Legal Description of the Electric Service Territory Boundary between Central Electric Cooperative, Inc. and Douglas Electric Cooperative, Inc.

Based on a prior agreement dated the 17th day of September, 1975, signed by Intercounty Electric Association, Inc. and Douglas Electric Cooperative, Inc., the following represents the legal description of the electric service territory boundary shared between Central Electric Cooperative, Inc. and Douglas Electric Cooperative, Inc.

1. BEGINNING at the Douglas County/Charles Mix County/Aurora County boundary at the NW corner of Section 7 of Township 100N (T100N), Range 66 West, Douglas County,
2. THENCE continue east following the Douglas County/Aurora County-Davison County boundary ending at the Douglas County/Davison County/Hutchinson County boundary at the NE corner of Section 12 of T100N, Range 62 West.
