Enclosed for filing please find a copy of an executed "Service Territory Exception" between Sioux Valley Southwestern Electric Cooperative Inc and the City of Flandreau Municipal Utilities.

This agreement seeks an exception to the existing service territory boundary in Moody County of South Dakota. The accompanying drawing provides additional graphic detail to this request.

For the convenience of all parties, Sioux Valley Southwestern Electric Cooperative Inc. has agreed to provide three phase service to a new irrigation system being built by Marc Burggraff, on land owned by INOR, Scott Ramsdell, as depicted on the diagram. While this parcel resides outside of Sioux Valley's assigned service territory, The City of Flandreau's facilities are over 2,700 feet away, whereas Sioux Valley's facilities are immediately adjacent to provide service to this site.

Included with the agreement between Sioux Valley and Flandreau is a consent signed by Marc Burggraff operator of this property and Scott Ramsdell, the landowner affected by this change. They are in support of this change.

Sioux Valley respectfully requests the commission approve this agreement.
