Enclosed for filing please find a copy of an executed "Service Territory Exception" between Sioux Valley Southwestern Electric Cooperative Inc and Southeastern Electric Cooperative Inc.

This agreement seeks an exception to the existing service territory boundary in rural Minnehaha County of South Dakota. The accompanying drawing provides additional graphic detail to this request.

For the convenience of all parties, Southeastern Electric has agreed to provide single phase service to a new home being built by Mike Van Hove as depicted on the diagram. While this parcel resides outside of Southeastern's assigned service territory, Sioux Valley's facilities are over 3,000 feet away, thus it would be more efficient for Southeastern to provide service to this site.

Included with the agreement between Sioux Valley and Southeastern is a consent signed by Mike Van Hove, the landowner affected by this change. He is in support of this change.

Sioux Valley respectfully requests the commission approve this agreement.
