- 2. THENCE continue north to the NW corner of Section 15 of T106N, R50W,
- 3. THENCE continue east to the NW corner of the NE ½ of Section 14 of T106N, R50W,
- 4. THENCE continue south to the NW corner of the SE ¼ of Section 14 of T106N, R50W,
- 5. THENCE continue west a point 241.5 feet east of the west boundary of Section 14 of T106N, R50W,
- 6. THENCE continue south 1038 feet to a point intersecting the north boundary of Lot A of Osgood Acres of Section 14 of T106N, R50W,
- 7. THENCE continue east 321.5 feet to the northeast corner of Lot A of Osgood Acres of Section 14 of T106N, R50W,
- 8. THENCE continue south 344 feet to the centerline of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific railroad right-of-way of Section 14 of T106N, R50W,
- 9. THENCE continue west along said centerline of said right-of-way to a point 183 feet east of the west boundary of Section 14 of T106N, R50W,
- 10. THENCE continue south to a point 183 feet east of the west boundary of Section 14 of T106N, R50W intersecting the south boundary of Section 14 of T106N, R50W,
- 11. THENCE continue east to the NE corner of the NW ¼ of Section 23 of T106N, R50W.

- 12. THENCE continue south to the SE corner of the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 23 of T106N, R50W,
- 13. THENCE continue west to the NW corner of the SE ¼ of Section 22 of T106N, R50W,
- 14. THENCE continue north ending at the SE corner of the NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 22 of T106N, R50W.
