



Jim,

Thank you for the detailed information provided on the approach permits and for taking the time to visit with me today.

The temporary access improvement on US212 at Double R Rd looks good.

The proposed new approach on US212 does not meet Access Location Criteria contained in Chapter 70:09:02 of South Dakota administrative rules, http://legis.sd.gov/Rules/DisplayRule.aspx?Rule=70:09:02:0A This portion of US212 is classified as Rural with a minimum spacing of 1000' between access points. A variance can be allowed to reduce the spacing to 660', but the approach does not have adequate sight distance for the 65 MPH posted speed limit. The proposed approach may be used for temporary access to US212 since pilot cars and temporary traffic control will be used when equipment is being delivered to the site and once the equipment is delivered to the site, the proposed approach should be entirely removed. Please visit with the applicant to see if the existing approach, 660'west of the proposed approach will suffice for equipment maintenance purposes.
