Dear Mr. Wynn,

As you are now aware, the FAA has issued favorable Determinations of No Hazard (DNHs) for 499 foot above ground level (AGL) wind turbines proposed at 45 locations. These filings were assigned aeronautical study numbers 2018-WTE-2362-OE through 2018-WTE-2406-OE.

Each determination is valid for coordinates within one arc second of what has been determined, provided the turbine height and total above mean sea level (AMSL) height does not increase. Each determination includes certain requirements which are outlined below.

First, after the turbine array is final and no further changes, additions, or removals will be made, Capitol Airspace can request that a marking and lighting study is completed by the FAA.

Second, we must notify the FAA within five days of each turbine reaching its greatest height. This notice will also be submitted by Capitol Airspace using FAA Form 7460-2 Part 2. This form will require confirming each turbine's location, height, and obstruction lighting.

Lastly, these determinations expire on December 4th, 2019. If construction has not started by November 4th, 2019, we recommend requesting a one-time extension of the determinations. If an extension is requested, the FAA will re-evaluate the wind project prior to issuing extensions.
