The project for which the Marion Development Foundation (MDF) is seeking economic/community development funding is commercial property acquisition for a new Fire Hall.

Project Description

The Marion Volunteer Fire Department has been pursuing a new Fire Hall project over the last year, beginning with site identification. Locating in Marion's central business district holds the most appeal, as this is where the current fire hall is located. The MDF recognized the opportunity to not only assist and support the community's fire department, but also continue with our efforts towards Main Street Revitalization. Our goal is to acquire consecutive lots with aging and/or vacant buildings, with the structures to be demolished. The MDF successfully purchased the first property in April 2014 (via a bank loan). We will continue to pursue a minimum of three (3) additional commercial property acquisitions. The funding received would be utilized to purchase properties located in our downtown/business district, all on consecutive lots, and each with a building in a visible state of disrepair. Additionally, funds would go towards the demolition of the existing structures on the lots. These lots would then would prepped and prime for new construction.

Community Benefits

Marion has a strong, thriving and proud volunteer fire department. With the everpresent need for more fire protection, based in part on businesses within our community (an always-expanding elevator and a large ethanol plant), and given the age and size limitations of the current fire hall, there is a clear need for and benefit to constructing a new fire hall. By aiding this effort, there is also a secondary, but also significant, benefit of improving the appearance and public safety of the community's Main Street, as some of the properties are in a visible state of disrepair. The Marion Development Foundation is investing in the business district & community at large to not only sustain, but also grow the services to and pride in our community. As we've seen accomplished previously with the industrial park we developed – activity breeds activity.
