Response:

In addition to the increased participation, the residential lighting program saw three LED lighting retrofits producing large kWh savings based on wattages removed and wattages installed. Additionally, the CFL giveaway offered by Otter Tail, in the Milbank area, accounted for 74,092 kWh savings.
