Response: (Roger Schiffman)

Juhl believes that Mr. LaFave's initial estimate for wind integration cost of \$0.24/MWh is reasonable. Juhl doesn't agree with Mr. LaFave's application of EIA natural gas price escalation to that value, and believes it would more appropriately be escalated at a rate of general inflation, such as 2% annually.
