Hi Bleau,

Thanks again for sharing NWE's calculated avoided cost numbers with me today. Per our conversation(s), I understand that NWE's calculation produced a levelized (flat) rate of around \$27.00/MWh for a period of 20 years. If in fact this is the case, we are quite a ways apart on where we (Juhl) expected the avoided cost rate to come in at.

In order for us to fully understand how NWE has arrived at this rate, we would like to respectfully request that when you provide us official notification of NWE's avoided cost rate via email on Monday, you also include a description of the methodology, inputs and assumptions NWE used to arrive at your final number.

We appreciate your effort on this and our goal is to arrive at a mutually agreeable tariff schedule in short order. Thanks again and have a great weekend.
