- 4. The claim for protection is based on ARSD § 20:10:01:39 (5).
 - A. The information contained within the confidential appendices of this report is information which has been made confidential under 18 C.F.R. 388.133 Critical Electric/Energy Infrastructure Information (CEII) and should be determined by the Commission to be confidential and entitled to protection

from disclosure or improper use. The confidential appendices contain specific engineering, vulnerability, or detailed design information about critical infrastructure that: (1) Relates details about the production, generation, transmission, or distribution of energy; (2) Could be useful to a person planning an attack on critical infrastructure; (3) Is exempt from mandatory disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act: and (4) Gives strategic information beyond the location of the critical infrastructure. Accordingly, Otter Tail respectfully requests that the Commission authorize confidential protection and treatment of this information.

B. In addition to the information described in Paragraph 5(A) of this request, the information contained within the confidential appendices of this report, specifically Appendix F, includes contact information for attendees of an information meeting for first responders. Some of this information includes personal email addresses and phone numbers which are generally recognized as confidential under South Dakota law unless provided with the intent for publication, which is not the case in this instance.
