1-1. Provide clarification on why the letter of understanding is filed with the commission.

The proposed letter of understanding provides for the permanent service allocation of a new addition to the City of Onida, and fixes the boundary of each utility's service area in the new addition, and resolves the issue of service area territories of the parties as to the newly annexed addition.

- 1-2. What effect on the new language have on the boundary between Oahe Electric and Onida?
 - a. Do the parties believe that the legal description should be edited from the agreement filed in Docket EL14-015? Currently, the description for the area in question reads, "THENCE continue north 330 feet along the centerline of North 9th Street to the intersection of Evergreen Ave."
 - b. Do the parties believe that the map needs to be updated?

A copy of the current service area map for this location, together with a copy of the plat of the new addition, showing the proposed service area within the area is attached. We believe the 330 feet is correct. We believe the service area map should be updated to show the boundary within the annexed area.
