What can I do? I want an answer please.

Attached is a short video I took this morning of turbine #14, which is 4900 ft from the deck on my house where I stood with the camera. Turn your volume up to understand how we now have to live. This decibel level has to be much higher than allowed. What do I do to check the level? Who can I hire? I don't want Prevailing Winds to check it for obvious reasons, they lie about everything.

This morning my ears hurt so bad I just want to drive away. It's constant pressure and popping in the ears. Am I suppose to spend the rest of my life like this? Who is going to buy this house that is 7 years old? These turbines are 3.8 MW, the largest onshore turbines in the nation and the SDPUC never even studied stats on noise or infrasound, other than the usual lies by Big Wind with their \$500/hour experts.

Would any of you want to live here? A mile away is our family's Century Farm. My brother has the building site and is calving now. He is only a half mile away from this turbine, and there are 13 within 3 miles of both his place and mine. He's in this environment all day and all night. The dog lays under the pickup most of the day trying to get away from it.

Does anybody at the PUC care about any of us forced to live like this?
