Dear Mr. Vrba:

I have received and reviewed your letter emailed to me on Monday, May 21st discussing your position on the avoided cost calculation related to your proposed Solar Facility. The avoided cost provided to you on April 27th was a 20-year levelized price of \$17.02 per MWh, which has not changed based on the observations in your letter.

As noted in your letter, our avoided cost was calculated consistent with the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission ruling in docket EL16-021. A value of zero (\$0 per MWh) has been calculated for energy, during periods when Black Hills Energy will not avoid energy costs. That is, when Black Hills is unable to reduce generation units, there are no more costs to offset by adding incremental solar energy. Therefore, a zero (\$0) value was provided during those hours. This approach aligns with the methodology applied in EL16-021, which is binding precedent in South Dakota.
