

Sweetland Wind Farm, LLC
Compliance Filing – Condition 31

Sweetland Wind Farm, LLC (“Sweetland”) provides the following information required pursuant to Condition No. 31 of the Settlement Stipulation approved by the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) in its July 31, 2019 Order Granting Joint Motion for Approval of Settlement Stipulation; Order Granting Permit to Construct Facility; Notice of Entry in Docket EL19-012.

31 *Within 90 days after the Project’s commercial operation date, Applicant shall submit a report to the Commission that provides the following information:*

31.a) *as-built location of structures and facilities, including drawings clearly showing compliance with the setbacks required by state and local governments and the voluntary commitments set forth in Table 9-1 of the Application;*

Sweetland: As-built maps providing the information required in subpart (a) are provided as **Attachment A**.

31.b) *the status of remedial activities for road damage, landowner property damage, crop damage, environmental damage, or any other damage resulting from Project construction activities; and*

Sweetland: Information regarding each category identified in subpart (b) is provided below:

Road Damage: Sweetland received Certificates of Completion from Hand County (on behalf of itself and Grand, Hiland, Hulbert, and Rose Hill Townships) and Pearl Township, which were filed in the docket on December 19, 2023 as an exhibit to Sweetland’s Motion for Release of Road and Public Infrastructure Bond (which was granted on January 25, 2024). Remedial activities for road damage are therefore complete.

Landowner Property Damage: Property restoration activities are complete.

Crop Damage: Sweetland has paid some crop damage claims and is in the process of analyzing and working with landowners regarding remaining crop damage requests and reimbursement. Sweetland anticipates this process will be completed by the end of April 2024.

Environmental Damage: Restoration of impacted areas is complete. No long-term environmental damaged has occurred.

31.c) *a summary of known landowner complaints and Applicant’s plan for resolving those complaints.*

Sweetland: Sweetland has no outstanding landowner complaints.
