In response to your questions about certain items on the sample forms submitted with the above - referenced Advice Letter, I can offer the following information at this time:

1. In our conversation this date, you had expressed concern that the term "Previous Balance" would not be understood to mean the amount owed before the current billing. You asked that I check as to whether a change could be made. I have communicated that request to our Billing Department and will respond as soon as I hear.
2. In the same conversation you asked if the definition of "Therm and Therm Factors" appearing on the back of the bill could be revised to show the parenthetical in bold in the last sentence. I have asked Billing to get back to me on that issue as well.
3. The question you had raised about the Certificate of Deposit led to a complete reworking of that form. That new form will be submitted once we have the answers to the first two questions.

I expect that our final submittal will occur by the 8th of October.



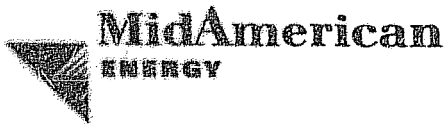

Dear Ms. Farris:

I have discussed your proposals with my client and have learned the following information.

1. You were concerned that "Previous Balance" might not be understood by our customers to mean the amount owing before the current billing. I agreed to check internally on this issue. Here is what I found. This format debuted at the end of 1998. Since that time we have logged the concerns expressed to us by our customers concerning the format. We have received 232 queries concerning the bill format to date; only one of those involved the "previous balance" line. To put those numbers in perspective, it is important to remember that well over 850,000 customers receive bills from MidAmerican each month. Therefore, as our customers do not appear to be confused by the wording as shown, we believe the best course would be to leave the wording as it appears.

2. The back of the bill is "bill stock" that is ordered in pre-printed form. We can make the change that you requested when we order again. We expect to need new stock around the first of the year.

The Certificate of Deposit form will be filed as a substitute for the form previously filed. I understand that it will be sent from our Regulated Pricing group on October 8. Although I will be out of the office on Friday, I will be checking my voice mail regularly and likely could reach you if you wish to discuss this further.

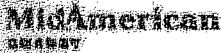
