We want to take this opportunity to express our support for the TransCanada Keystone Pipeline Project. We strongly urge the PUC to approve this project.

We are aware that the Pipeline Hazardous Materials Safety Administration has reviewed the design for the Keystone Pipeline and concluded that additional precautions and conditions will make the Keystone Pipeline "as safe or safer" than other pipelines. We are also aware that the Keystone Draft Environmental Impact Statement prepared by federal regulators in accordance with the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act indicates the project will have "limited adverse environmental impacts during both construction and operation, and would be an environmentally acceptable action."

We are aware of the significant benefits the pipeline stands to bring to the State of South Dakota. On a personal level, the project has already resulted in a contract for this firm for surveying services.
