



On behalf of TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, L.P. I am pleased to give you notice of upcoming public meetings convened by the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission to take public comments concerning the proposed KeystoneXL pipeline project.

You are receiving this notice because you are the landowner of record for property within the affected area in Harding, Butte, Perkins, Meade, Pennington, Haakon, Jones, Lyman and Tripp Counties in South Dakota, where the proposed underground KeystoneXL pipeline is to be sited.

Pursuant to law, the Public Utilities Commission will hold public hearings to take comments from the public. The hearings will be held :

The great bulk of the time will be reserved for accepting public comments on the proposal.
