TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, L.P. has filed an application with the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission for a permit to site and construct the Keystone XL pipeline Harding, Butte, Perkins, Meade, Pennington, Haakon, Jones, Lyman and Tripp Counties in South Dakota. The proposal is to construct a 36" underground pipeline to deliver crude oil from Hardisty, Alberta, Canada, through the named counties, to the Port Arthur and east Houston areas of Texas.

Pursuant to law, the South Dakota Public Utilities Commission will take comments on the application, from the public, at public hearings. The hearings will be held:

- April 27th at Noon CDT in Winner at the Winner Play House
- April 27th at 7:00 P.M. MDT in Philip at the Fine Arts School
- April 28th at 6:00 P.M. MDT in Buffalo at the Memorial Recreation Center

TransCanada Keystone Pipeline, L.P. will present a short presentation designed to give context to the comments of the public regarding the proposal. The great bulk of the time will be reserved for accepting public comments on the proposal.


