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14 **1. Please state your name and address for the record.**

15 Answer: My name is John Phillips. My business address is 7505 NW Tiffany Springs Parkway,

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18 **2. What is your role with the Keystone XL Pipeline Project?**

19 Answer: I am the US Project Director for Universal Ensco (UEI) for the US portion of the Steele
20 City Segment of the Keystone XL Project (Project).
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22 **3. Have you provided testimony previously?**

23 Answer: Yes, I provided pre-filed testimony at the time of the filing of Keystone's application in
24 this proceeding.
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26 **4. What are your responsibilities on the Keystone XL Project?**

27 Answer: I am responsible for the engineering, survey, and constructability of the US-Steele City
28 Segment of the Project.
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30 **5. Are you responsible for those portions of the updated application that Keystone**
31 **submitted in response to a Staff Data Request on August 21, 2009, that deal with**
32 **construction camps?**

33 Answer: Yes, I am responsible for the discussion of construction camps at Sections 2.2.4, 6.2.1,
34 6.2.2, and 6.2.3 of the updated application
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36 **7. Could you briefly summarize the information provided in the updated application**
37 **on construction camps?**

38 Answer: As discussed in the updated application, some areas of the Project in South Dakota lack
39 adequate temporary housing. At these remote locations, Keystone has determined that it needs
40 two temporary construction camps, to be located near Union Center and Winner. The camp sites
41 will be approximately 80 acres in size, of which 30 acres will be used as a contractor yard and 50
42 acres will be used as the camp site. Each camp will be sized to accommodate approximately 600
43 people. The camps will be permitted, constructed, and operated in compliance with all
44 applicable regulations, as summarized in Table 5 of the updated application. Each camp site will
45 be restored after completion of construction. As discussed in Sections 6.2.1, 6.2.2, and 6.2.3 of

46 the updated application, Keystone will work with local officials, local power providers, and local
47 utilities to address the adequacy of local infrastructure in these locations.
