Re: Docket HP09-01 - South Dakota Access Roads

Dear Ms. Van Gerpen:

Attached for filing in compliance with Condition 28 of the Commission's Amended Final Decision and Order dated June 29, 2010 is a list identifying private and new access roads that will be used during construction.

In further compliance with Condition 28, please be advised that Keystone may leave private access roads in place after construction where requested by the landowner. However, where the landowner requests that the road be removed, Keystone will restore the area as close as practical to its preconstruction condition. The restoration measures are similar to those used on the construction right-of-way and generally include removing imported gravel, decompacting soil (where necessary), replacing topsoil (where stripped), restoring original contours, stabilizing disturbed areas, reseeding the site, and monitoring revegetative success.

These reclamation practices apply to any access road included in the list.
