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FRAC-OUT DETAILS

On 7/30/10, one minor frac-out occurred while boring 185th Street and the associated wetlands. The drilling mud surfaced on 185th Street. Drilling activities were halted to relieve the pressure in the hole. Earthen berms and straw hay bales were used to contain the drilling mud. A vacuum truck was used to remove the drilling mud. A second minor frac-out occurred on 7/31/10 while boring wetland PEM-23. The drilling mud surfaced just north of Station # 68+00. Drilling activities were halted to relieve the pressure in the hole. In addition, a different drilling mud formulation was deployed for the remaining portion of the drill. Earthen berms were used to contain the drilling mud and a vacuum truck was used to remove the drilling mud. Once both drilling operations were completed both areas were restored, as close as possible, to their pre-construction conditions.
